A, B	Arthur's Tooth/Sick as a Dog 2 films on 1 tape. Everyone in the class has a lost tooth except Arthur. When he finally has a loose tooth, he tries everything to get it out, but is won't budge. Will Arthur have to go through life with a mouthful of baby	30:00

teeth? Arthur's dog is sick and has to spend the night at the vet's. Could it be the hot dogs and Halloween candy Arthur's been feeding him?

- A, B **Franklin and The Tooth Fairy** **30:00**
It's a big shock to Franklin when he discovers he's not like his friends. They're all losing their baby teeth, indicating that they're growing up. Since turtles don't have teeth, Franklin conspires to get a present from the Tooth Fairy by leaving a tiny pebble as a turtle tooth.
- A, B **Timmy the Tooth "Lost My Brush"** **34:00**
This adventure teaches children about brushing, flossing, cavities, and nutrition with an underlying message that before you go out to play, you should always let someone in charge know where you are going and when you are coming home. Features the characters Timmy the Tooth, Brushbrush, the Cavity Goon, Ms. Sweety and Timmy's Flossmore Valley friends.
- A, B **Timmy the Tooth "Big Mouth Gulch"** **32:00**
Timmy and his friends travel back to the wild, wild West for a showdown against the Cavity Goon. Here, duels are fought with brains, not brawn; and that means a spelling bee!
- A, B **Melvin's Magical Mouth Museum** **30:00**
This video can be used as a stand-alone half-hour oral health care lesson or as a supplement. Includes a discussion guide that is loosely scripted with questions that can be easily adapted. Covers: brushing, flossing, healthy eating, sealants and importance of regular dental visits.
- G **Toothbrushing with Charlie Brown/It's Dental Flossophy Charlie Brown**
2 films on 1 tape. Charlie Brown teaches Linus and Snoopy how to brush. Lucy knows it all, except that Snoopy used her brush! Lucy teaches Snoopy and Charlie Brown flossing.
- A, B, C **Heroes vs. Plaque** **5:00**
DVD features Spider-Man and the Fantastic Four battling tooth decay. Teaches dental health basics.
- A,B,C **The Munchers** **9:40**
Lively musical, colorful clay figures present nutrition and plaque control message.
- A,B,C **Seal in a Smile** **4:30**
An educational video for children that teaches them about sealants and the important role they play in fighting cavities.
- C, D **The Video Project** **30:00**
Reviews six important topics: regular dental visits, daily brushing & flossing, healthy eating habits, use of mouthguards, risks of mouth jewelry, tobacco and oral health. Comes with discussion guide for teachers.
- B,C,D,E **Prevention for Ages 6-18** **6:00**
Teaches parents, children and teens about permanent teeth, space maintainers, X-rays, sealants and more.
- C,D,E **Smokeless Tobacco: The Big Dipper** **19:00**
In a lively news magazine format young narrators probe the issues with "Kid-in-the-street" interviews. Presents strong evidence of risks associated with chewing tobacco.
- C,D,E **Smokeless Tobacco (Check it Out!)**
A rock video, where the singing groups presents hazards of smokeless tobacco.

- C,D,E,F **“Innocent Addiction” The Story of Gruen VonBehrens**
True-life story of a young man who began using spit tobacco at age 13 and was diagnosed with oral cancer at age 17. He’s had almost 30 disfiguring surgeries to save his life, including one surgery that removed half his neck muscles, lymph nodes, and half of his tongue. He now travels the country to tell young people how damaging spit tobacco really can be.
- C,D,E,F **The Haunted Mouth** **13:00**
Invisible B. Plaque hauntingly draws the viewer through the dental health message.
- D, E **Watch Your Mouth!!** **30:00**
Includes a classroom discussion guide for a complete and flexible ½ hour lesson plan. Discusses the risks of mouth jewelry and tobacco, the importance of good nutrition and the use of mouthguards.
- F **Baby Bottle Tooth Decay** **5:00**
Educational program for parents showing how to prevent baby bottle tooth decay.
- F **Options, Dental Health in the Later Years** **15:48**
Dental disease is not an inevitable result of aging. Stresses prevention of periodontal disease. Excellent for healthy older adults.
- G **Taking Care of Your Teeth and Gums** **5:00**
Covers the basics of preventive home care in an informative and easy to follow format. *Available in VHS or DVD, please specify which you prefer.*
- G **Dental Health: A Guide for African Americans** **28:30**
Featuring celebrities Blair Underwood and Nia Long. Discusses tooth decay, gum disease, oral cancer, and other oral health problems, while emphasizing brushing, flossing and regular dental visits. Accompanying guide book also addresses African-American’s in dentistry and features a list of questions to ask your dentist.
- D,E,F **16 mm Film - Portrait of the Enemy**
Film about periodontal disease. It uses the analogy of a basketball game strategy in dealing with gum problems.

Books

Open Wide – Tooth School Inside

Filled with fun facts and illustrations about everything from tooth anatomy, brushing & flossing, the functions of baby teeth & primary teeth, diet, and tooth decay. Even has two short quizzes covering the most important topics. Aimed mainly toward elementary aged children.

Where Do Baby Teeth Go?

Covers all the questions children have about losing their first teeth, the importance of brushing and flossing, cavities, and even a visit to the dentist. Most appropriate for lower elementary ages.

The Revolt of the Foolish Molar

Plays for elementary aged children complete with music.

The Missing Tooth

Two best friends are so much alike – they even have a tooth missing in the same place. One day they have a

fight because they aren't the same anymore, can best friends be different? Grades 1-3.

Arthur Tricks the Tooth Fairy

Arthur loses a tooth and gets money from the tooth fairy. D.W. wants money too so she tries to trick the tooth fairy.

The Bernstein Bears Visit the Dentist

Brother and Sister visit the dentist. Brother gets a cavity filled and the dentist checks out Sister's loose tooth. Covers tools used in the dental office also.

Little Rabbit's Loose Tooth

Little Rabbit loses her first tooth.

No Tooth, No Quarter!

Walter loses his lost tooth and now he won't get any money. And the tooth fairy needs to find the perfect tooth so that she can go to the Decay Prevention Ball. Grades 2-3.

No Strings Attached

Short, fun rhyming story explaining the need to floss. Appropriate for all ages.

Oral hygiene presentation covers brushing and flossing, diet and regular dental visits. Cosmetic presentation covers all major cosmetic procedures and includes before-and-after shots.

Chew on This!

CD-ROM PowerPoint presentation that explains topics of particular relevance to teens and encourages them to take responsibility for their smiles. Includes information on tobacco, oral piercing, frequent snacking, bad breath, eating disorders, braces, home care, wisdom teeth, mouthguards, and tooth whitening.

Models

Full Mouth Model and Large Toothbrush

Especially effective with children, the model allows you to demonstrate proper brushing and flossing techniques. Features two removable teeth. Toothbrush is 12" long with rubber massage tip. Model is 3"H x 4"W x 3 1/2"D

XL Mouth Model and Toothbrush

Giant model has long metal hinges that allow mouth to be put in different positions. Model is 4 3/4"H x 6 1/2"W x 5"D. Toothbrush is 14 1/2" long.

Plak Posse Palz

Plush animal characters have full mouth models in a size perfect for hands-on brushing demonstrations to children. Each model has a toothbrush to use for demonstration. Characters size ranges from 8" to 12" overall height. Please indicate on your request form if you prefer a particular character: Finnegan Z. Fish, Allie Z. Gator, Little BG Roo, Shelley Z. Starfish, or Bo Z. Bison.

Diseased Tooth Model

Includes two pre-molars and molars that show a cracked tooth, a filling, a post in a finished root canal, inflamed gums, diseased pulp, an abscess, cavity decay, and a porcelain crown. 3"H x 5"L x 1"W.

Mr. Gross Mouth

This hinged model of the teeth, tongue, and oral cavity show the effects of using smokeless tobacco. A bottle of tobacco juice comes with each model and instructions show how to make the tongue "spit". This model is

three times normal size and is mounted on a wooden base.

Foam Tooth Model

Removable foam pieces. Includes background information, an activity card, teaching ideas and extension activities.

Foam Toddler's Teeth Model

Removable foam pieces. Includes background information, an activity card, teaching ideas and extension activities.

Cross Section Tooth Model

Foam cross-section model tooth has one side labeled with the parts of a tooth and the other side labeled with letters. Five inches. Great for older kids and adults.
